PRIMARY PRODUCTION

1. PRIVATELY OWNED LAND

- Beef cattle production with scattered dairy farms and fat lamb enterprises
- Dairying with some beef cattle and fat lamb production
- Sheep (grown for wool) some beef production and occasional cropping
- Potato growing
- Lalorbe Valley cities, towns and industrial areas
- Softwood forestry

2. PUBLIC LAND

- Managed for nature conservation, recreation and erosion prevention
- Generally forested land managed for a variety of uses including water production, low intensity logging, gravel production, nature conservation, grazing and recreation
- Areas managed especially for intensive timber production (including both softwood and hardwood forests)
- Areas held for coal production
- Public land used for grazing – in addition various small areas of public land in the southern half of the study area are grazed under licence and certain areas purchased for reafforestation are opened for agistment before planting takes place
- Public land used occasionally for honey production
