I would like to register my concern about the proposal to allow deer hunting in the Mt Cole State Forest. Such an activity is incompatible with the many LTOs which operate in this forest for educational purposes, including Cave Hill Creek (a major local employer), Auscamps and Take Shape Adventures. A number of other organisations such as universities and schools also visit the forest for outdoor education or training purposes. Clearly there is great potential for inadvertent harm or injury to be caused to school children and others by deer shooters. I am sure that there are other more manageable methods of controlling feral species besides intermixing hunters and school children to say nothing of the many other groups who take advantage of the forest for walking and recreation.
