Many rivers are proposed to have their headwaters protected, but not the Wimmera river for whatever reasons,--these headwaters really should be excluded from 'even aged stand management'(clearfelling) and a survey conducted to locate any other old large trees that have survived the heavy logging of Mt Cole State Forest, over our historical period. 2.
