With regard to the proposal to turn the Wombat State Forest into a National or Regional Park or re-introduced industrial logging to this area please note my objection to these proposals. As a user of this area by a number of uses including camping, dog walking, trail riding and prospecting I wish that the current status be maintained and enhanced by the development of a ecological restoration plan to return it to a more natural structure and species composition. I am aware of the current degraded condition and would like this to be improved but not at the cost of restricting use within this area.
