To whom it may concern With regard the area assigned for DPI Guide To Deer hunting on map sheet 89 grid reference 35km east - 30km North adjacent to Old Boolarra Road Foster. This area is adjacent to my cleared beef cattle grazing farm. Since the creation of this map in July 2014 we have had many native animals (wombats and Wallaby's) shot on my land as a result of this map bringing hunters to the area. There is no suitable deer hunting in this area and no real suitable place to leave a car as it is a single lane road. For this reason some hunters now shoot on my cleared land even though it is clearly sign posted NO SHOOTING. The idea to create a hunting area where it is inaccessible and next to the little franklin river reserve still astounds me. I have rang the police and there is little they can do to protect the wildlife. Maybe a little time to complete a site inspection would have been helpful in realizing what a mistake it is to allocate this as a hunting permitted area.

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
