- Notes
- The reference numbers of the various reserves shown on this map refer to the same general areas as those indicated in the L.C.C. Final Recommendations for the Melbourne area of January 1977 - although some changes to boundaries may have taken place in the interim. A30-A35 and H27, however, are new reference numbers to indicate changes in land use category.
 - The original Melbourne area has been divided into two districts to facilitate detailed investigation. The sequence of numbers indicating a particular land use category on the map is therefore incomplete, eg in bushland reserves; the number sequence - I1 - I82 represents 34 separate areas in the Melbourne area, District 1.
 - The map also indicates areas of public land which were acquired for conservation or other purposes subsequent to the 1977 recommendations; these are indicated by letters only eg GHP - Gellbrand Hill Park. (see text)
 - Some reserves cannot be accurately defined at this map scale; these reserves are indicated by a coloured dot eg - D56
 - Public land water frontage reserves cannot be accurately defined at this map scale nor are reserves indicated. Refer to the appropriate Parish plan to determine the boundaries of the reserve and whether it is on one, or both, sides of the stream.
